## **Online Theory Instruction**

- 1 Driver education theory instruction is available online through a partnership with the Edward Savioz Driver Training School.
- 2 Students can register at www.KeysToDriving.com
- **3** Online instruction comprises 30 hours of instruction.
- 4 Curriculum complies with current Pennsylvania Department of Education regulations.
- 6 Depending on school district policy, students may receive .25 academic credits for completing online instruction.
- 6 Students who complete the 30-hour course will receive a Certificate of Completion with which they may apply for a reduction in insurance. premium.\*

## **Behind-the-Wheel Instruction**

- 1 Behind-the-wheel instruction provides students with six hours of trainingsix hours behind the wheel of a car provided by the BCIU.
- **2** Curriculum complies with current PDE regulations and all instructors are PDE-certified.
- 3 Students may receive .10 academic credits for completing behind-thewheel instruction.
- 4 Students who complete the 6-hour course should access their "My Learning Plan" account to print the Certificate of Driver Training to apply for a reduction in insurance premium.\*
