# PRESCHOOL 2,500+ CHILDREN EARLY INTERVENTION

Every year across the Commonwealth, more than 58,000 preschool children (ages 3-5) with disabilities and other developmental delays are served through Preschool Early Intervention programs. As required under state and federal law, Early Intervention providers supply a full continuum of special education services to every eligible child that needs them. And like K-12 public education, these services are provided at no cost to families. Thanks to the services they receive, children with disabilities develop and learn to their fullest potential and are able to enter elementary school better prepared for success. Thousands will either require no special education services, or the level of support they need will be reduced.



#### **BERKS COUNTY PROGRAM FUNDING NEEDS:**

- Increased service options for students with autism
- Increased service needs to support students in inclusive programs (Pre-K Counts, Head Start, Child Care)
- Increased behavioral supports and services to prevent suspension/expulsion and meet mental health needs

- 88.4% improved acquisition and use of early language and communication skills
- 81.8% improved positive social-emotional skills (including social relationships)
- 85.8% improved use of appropriate behavior to meet their needs
